Despite the growing use of traditional methods that are valued, the following outlines a selection of

strategies offered in 2001-2002.

THE BLACK FOLDER

A folder of information about the ESF, referred to as 'The Black Folder" contains a number of inserts that are of interest to prospective parents and those wanting an overview of what we are and who we are.

SCHOOL NEWSLETTERS

Most schools publish a newsletter which is distributed to parents on a regular basis, many are now available by email.

The Foundation Management Office has established a telephone hotline which offers prerecorded information.

ESF VIDEO

An ESF promotional video in English, Cantonese and Potunghua was initially produced in 1996; it was updated in 2000, and is now available on CD and the internet, see page 7 for more information.

ESF WEB SITE: MAIN

The ESF Website at http://www.esf.edu.hk receives over two hundred 'hits' per day and has been particularly useful at the start of each academic year and during recruitment.

ESF WEB SITE: SHAMBLES

The ESF Website at http://www.shambles.net is designed specifically to support learning and teaching across the Foundation. It is also designed to support all members of the ESF, students, teachers, parents, management and support staff. In 2000-2001 the site was updated to provide an improved searching facility, it also has a database of over 11,000 education-specific web sites.

Parent Teacher Associations' publications and meetings have continued to be a valued part of the Foundation since we started in the mid 1960s. Most of the work is from volunteers and this reinforces how fortunate we are in having such supportive parents.

THE BLUE BOOK - SC/AMS

The ESF publishes Schools Circulars and Administrative memoranda on a regular basis on a variety of subjects. These are filed in a "Blue Ring-Binder", copies usually to be found with school principals and in staffrooms and also on Shambles at http://www.shambles.net/filearea/

MAILING LISTS - LISTSERVs

If you have access to email then you are able to subscrible to several ESF mailing lists (listservs) to receive copies of information automatically.
